

Student newspaper visualizations

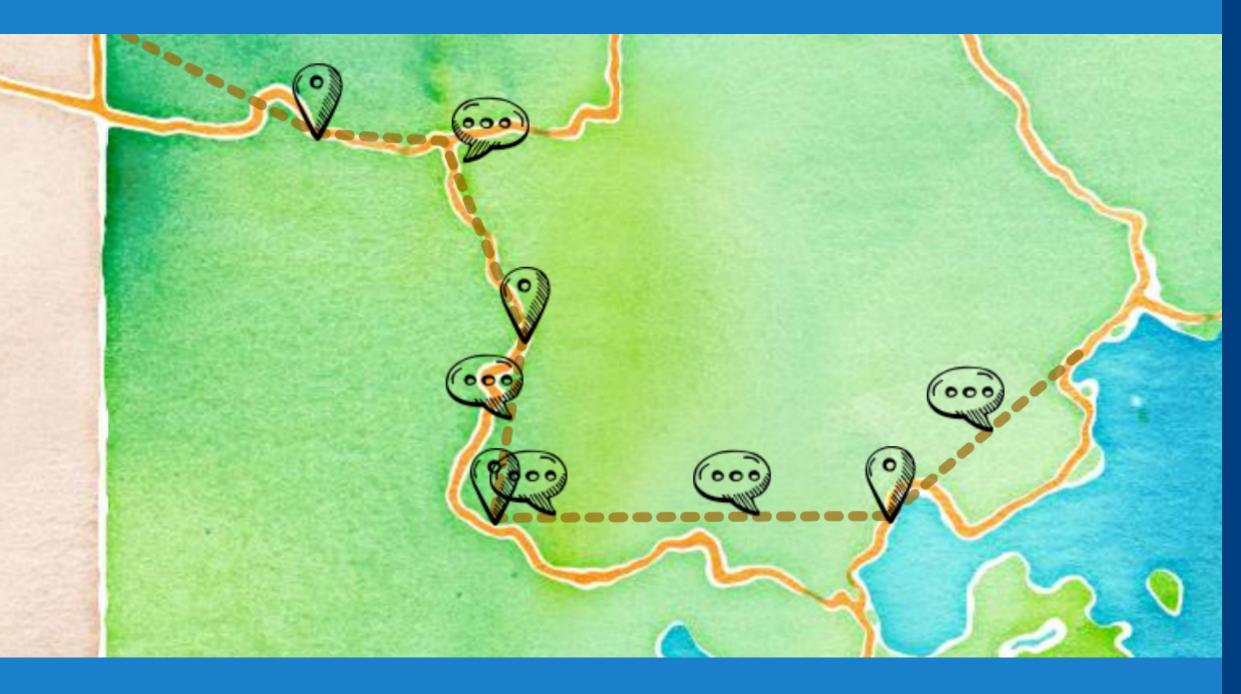


- The Exponent has been MSU's student newspaper since the 1890's.
- Dillon Monday used a Python script to clean the optical character recognition (OCR) of digitized newspapers in the MSU Library collection
- Dillon then created word clouds showing word usage in news articles in the 1890's versus 2016.
- The Venn diagram at right illustrates the number of words used in the 1890's versus today, including the number of unique and overlapping words in each era.

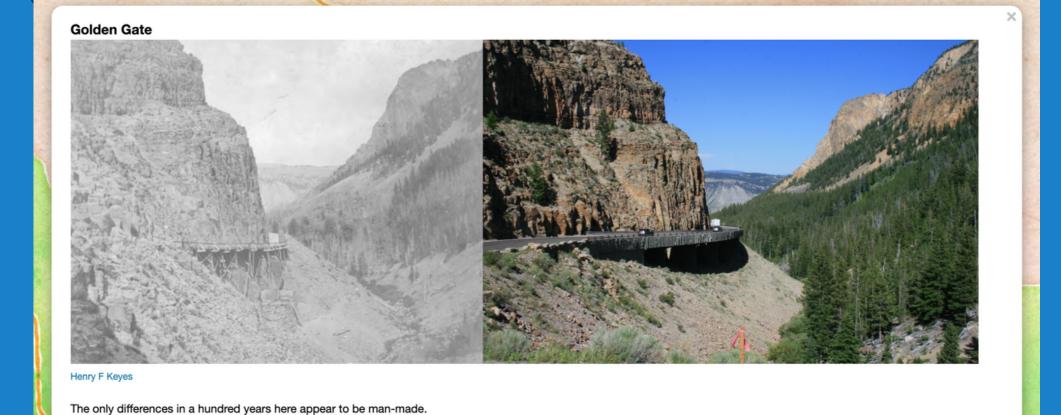

Storymap of historical expeditions in Yellowstone



- This storymap walks users through the Yellowstone expeditions of Henry Keyes (1899) and Charles Hoff (1908), showcasing historic photographs of Yellowstone, and Keyes' and Hoff's journal entries.
- Dillon Monday used Leaflet JS to build the app.
- A slider allows users to follow each journey through time and space.

"We then hitched up and started for Mount Washburn. We left the down Ravine Road to our left and went up the hill like pilgrims. We all marveled at the road scored out of solid ledges and wondered what it had cost the government. On top, we found plenty of old snow and some new drifts. Altitude ten thousand and two hundred feet. Yellowstone Lake was in sight. We pulled to Tower Falls and camped."

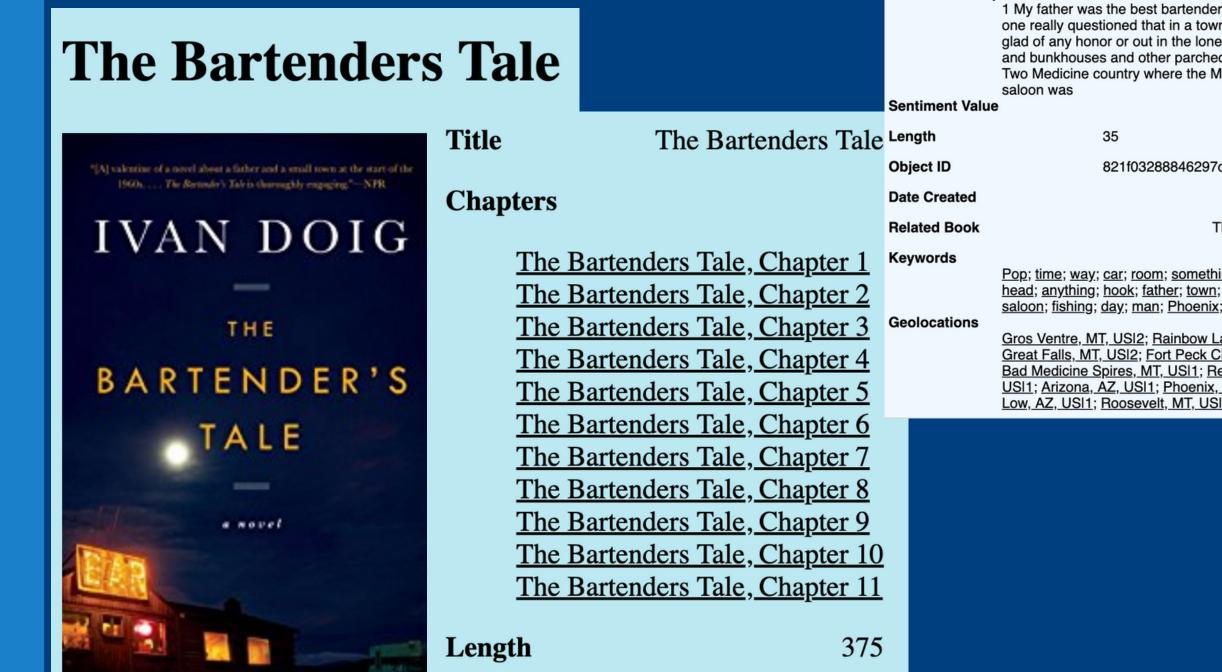

- Character mapping across each book shows occurrences of people in Doig's fictional world
- Sentiment analysis allows users to find chapters that match a feeling
- Entity recognition of placenames/landmarks enabling search for these entities
- Collaborative filtering of works based on keyword, sentiment, character occurrences, landmarks and placenames used to recommend similar works
